

# Edith Franklin Pottery Scholarship

## Program Information

The Edith Franklin Pottery Scholarship is available for graduating high school seniors, current college students, novice/beginner potters, accomplished potters, and art educators who currently reside in Northwest Ohio or Southeast Michigan pursuing a degree in ceramic arts with a focus in pottery OR seeking additional education/training in the ceramic arts. Funds can be used toward fees and expenses associated with college tuition, workshops, classes, seminars, or conferences, but they must be used in the same calendar year the scholarship is awarded. This scholarship may be renewed for additional years after the initial award (not guaranteed), provided the student meets the renewal conditions. Several scholarships in varying amounts will be awarded.

### APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

*Applications are first carefully reviewed by the Community Foundation staff to verify their eligibility.*

1. Must reside in Northwest Ohio or Southeast Michigan (Lenawee County & Monroe County Only).
2. Must be pursuing a degree in ceramic arts with a focus on pottery OR seeking additional education/training in the ceramic arts.

### SELECTION CRITERIA

*Eligible applicants are reviewed by a Scholarship Advisory Committee (SAC) based on the following criteria, in order of significance.*

1. Individual Motivation, Ability & Potential
2. Photo Quality of Works of Art
