

Toledo Rowing – Anderton L. “Pete” Bentley, Jr. Memorial Scholarship

Program Information

The Toledo Rowing – Anderton L. “Pete” Bentley, Jr. Memorial Scholarship is available for graduating high school seniors who are members of a team which rows out of the Philip LeBoutillier, Jr. Memorial Boat House and who are pursuing a full-time or part-time degree at an accredited post-secondary institution. This is a one-time, non-renewable award.

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

Applications are first carefully reviewed by the Community Foundation staff to verify their eligibility.

1. Must row out of the Philip LeBoutillier, Jr. Memorial Boat House (Verified by Chairman, Toledo Rowing Foundation Scholarship Committee).
2. Must be an active rowing participant (rower or coxswain) for at least one year or two rowing seasons prior to application deadline.
3. Must have achieved distinction in competitive rowing on the league or regional level or above.
4. Must have completed volunteer hours during high school rowing career to Toledo Rowing programs.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Eligible applicants are reviewed by a Scholarship Advisory Committee (SAC) based on the following criteria, in order of significance.

1. Academic Achievements (Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA)
2. Test Scores (Scholastic Aptitude)
3. Volunteer Involvement with Toledo Rowing programs
4. Work Experience
5. Coach's Recommendation
6. Financial Need
